Introducing the e-Textbook

All undergraduate students can access their textbooks through VitalSource - an etextbook platform designed to access textbooks from anywhere, anytime online or offline. Students and academic staff teaching the module have been provided with training on how to use the platform.

Digital collection of books

We have subscribed to a number of online databases to access eBooks.

Academic eBooks collection – this is an EBSCOhost database has more than 172,000 e-titles on a variety of disciplinary subjects for all levels. Registered users can download specific titles and read them offline.

Knovel eBooks – provides access to engineering research, with a search function, interactive tools, and equations to discover.

Dawsonera – provides access to individual titles purchased by the University. Users can search the whole collection and request specific titles they need.

All eBook databases can be accessed on and off campus using your University account details.

BSpace – digital repository of University research works

This is a collection of 900+ students' works submitted electronically.

BSpace runs on open resource software used by many universities for building open digital repositories. It is an online digital archive to preserve, store and provide access to all types of digital content.


Learn how to: download eBooks through EBSCOhost platform





Revised circulation policies

The policies below have been approved:

- Overdue charge of AED2 per day per book will be billed if the item is not renewed or returned on time for all registered users.
- Loan period has been extended for all students to twenty-one days.
- Loan limit is increased to ten books for all students.
- Renewal limit of five times maximum after which users must return the book.
- If a book is recalled, loan period will be reduced. Users need to return the books on its new due date.
- Maximum overdue count is set to five items. This means that if a user has five items overdue, they will NOT be allowed to borrow any library materials until the outstanding bill is paid.


Around BUID...

BUID staff participated in the Dubai Fitness Challenge from 26 October to 24 November 2018 to encourage people to live a healthier, active lifestyle even at work.





BUID team joined the Dubai Marathon on 25 January 2019.


